

How to reach the venue:

By car:

From autobahn A1: Use exit Hemelingen; direction „Stadtmitte“ (Center)

- Feeder road **Pfalzburgerstr.** until end
- turn left into **Malerstr.** until end
- turn right into **Osterdeich** until corner **Stader Str.**
- At traffic light turn right into **Stader Str.**
- After the first traffic light see the big building to the right

There are only very few parking places around the venue. Please park at a larger distance (The soccer stadium “Weserstadion” is 10 min to walk).

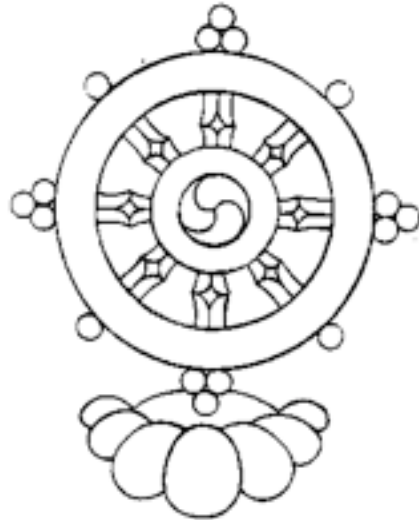

JETSÜN KHANDRO RINPOCHE

is one of the few female dharma teachers in our time.

Born as the eldest daughter of the head of the Nyingma Tradition, H.H. Mindrolling Trichen, she was later recognized by the 16th Karmapa as the incarnation of the "Great Dakini of Tsurphu", Khandro Orgyen Tsomo, one of the most famous female teachers of her epoch.

Khandro Rinpoche holds the lineages of the Nyingma and the Kagyü school.

Rinpoche's spiritual teachers are in particular H.H. Dalai Lama, H.H. Mindrolling Trichen as well as H.H. Gyalwa Karmapa and H.H. Dilgo Kyentse Rinpoche.

She is founder and spiritual leader of the Samten Tse retreat place in Mussoorie, India, and is in charge of her father's monastery (Headquarter of Mindrolling in Dehra Dun).

Rinpoche has been developing widespread activities in Europe and in America for over 18 years, holds her teachings in English and has become well-known through her outstanding, clear, direct and profound teachings.

Rinpoche will continue the teachings of the Minling Dorsem Cycle.

The Minling Dorsem or Ati Zabdon teachings are based on a terma, discovered by Terdag Lingpa, and on the corresponding commentaries, composed by Terdag Lingpa himself and his brother Lochen Dharmashri.

In particular Rinpoche will expound the ngöndro practices.

Although the cycle has started already 2008, it still is possible to enter as a newcomer.
